# Message from the Village President



Dear residents of River Forest:

Spring is finally here! I am sure that all of you are as excited as I am to begin enjoying nicer weather.

In March, the Village Board of Trustees and I approved an amendment to the redevelopment agreement for the project at Lake and Lathrop. This marks a step forward on the project and brings the developer closer to the process of demolishing and remediating the property. This is an exciting project for our Village as it will add commercial retail and hopefully a long-awaited restaurant.



To continue our commitment to <u>Dementia Friendly River Forest</u>, I signed a <u>pledge</u>, approved by the Board of Trustees, to make River Forest a place for successful aging. Additionally, members of our <u>Police</u> and <u>Fire</u> Departments have already begun training

provided by Dementia Friendly River Forest to enhance their understanding of what it's like to live with dementia.

On Monday, April 8, the Village Board will hold a public hearing for our upcoming budget year starting May 1, 2019 and ending April 30, 2020. The hearing will be in the first floor Community Room of Village Hall at 6 PM prior to the regular Village Board of Trustees meeting. Click here to view the draft copy of the budget. In addition to our budget hearing, the Village Board of Trustees and I will review and accept additional public comment on the Village's <u>Comprehensive Plan</u>. Residents are encouraged to view the <u>draft Comprehensive Plan</u> and learn more about this important document. The Comprehensive Plan will be

brought back to a Special Village Board of Trustees Meeting on Monday, May 13 for approval.

River Forest will be celebrating Earth Day on Saturday, April 27 and once again will have many activities engaged around making our community healthier, including the following:

- From 8 to 10 AM, the Park District will host the annual Des Plaines River and Thatcher Woods Clean-up. This event will take place rain or shine. Pre-registration is recommended and available online. Everything you need to know can be found by clicking here.
- If you participate in curbside composting, the finished compost product will be available all day at the Metra Commuter East Lot, also known as the Depot. Bring your own bucket. The event is sponsored by the Sustainability Commission. To sign up for curbside composting, click here.

Please save May 4 as it will be this year's Recycling Extravaganza. This event, also sponsored by the Sustainability Commission, will be held from 8 AM to 1 PM at the United Methodist Church, at the corner of Lake Street and Thatcher Avenue. The Extravaganza will again be accepting electronics.
