PROCLAMATION DESIGNATING FRIDAY, APRIL 24, 2026 AS ARBOR DAY

PROCLAMATION DESIGNATING MAY 3 – 9, 2026 AS COMPOST AWARENESS WEEK

WHEREAS, the Village of River Forest has declared the first full week of May to be the annual Compost Awareness Week; and

WHEREAS, composting is a way of returning organic resources to the soil to restore the health of the soil and enable its essential function in the carbon cycle; and

WHEREAS, applying finished compost is a proven method of growing healthy food, conserving water during extreme drought, providing resiliency during flooding conditions, reducing water consumption and non-point pollution, decreasing the dependence on chemical fertilizers, decreasing erosion, carbon sequestration and remediating fire damaged lands; and

WHEREAS, it is critical to recognize composting as an effective form of resource recovery, waste reduction, reuse and recycling, and pollution reduction; and

WHEREAS, materials such as yard trimmings, fruit and vegetable cuttings, acceptable food scraps and organics, are all able to be composted and processed into a beneficial product known as compost; and

WHEREAS, the Village of River Forest's Curbside Compost program includes over 550 households and compost drop-off locations at each Village facility; and

WHEREAS, over 300 tons of organic materials are collected annually within the Village of River Forest and turned into compost; and

WHEREAS, each year, River Forest Public Works distributes over 4000 cubic feet of finished compost to participants in the Curbside Composting program, enriching the soil in yards and gardens throughout the community from the same materials previously collected; and

WHEREAS, communities, through their local governments, highway departments, soil conservation service and extension offices, and public works professionals, can have significant impact on clean water, soil, climate resiliency and landfill diversion by using compost for projects at all scales; and

WHEREAS, International Compost Awareness Week is a publicity and education initiative to showcase compost production and demonstrate compost use; and

WHEREAS, composting creates green jobs and infrastructure for cities and states who implement composting programs; and



WHEREAS, this year's theme is **Compost: Feed the Soil that Feeds Us**. The 2026 theme was chosen with the goal of highlighting the benefits of composting in agriculture and food production, and its role in supporting healthy, nutritious food, and by extension, healthy people and communities. Beyond responsible waste management, composting recognizes the interconnectedness between every person who eats and the earth that provides all of our food, as well as our agency in feeding the earth our scraps so that the soil may continue to provide for us abundantly. Compost grows healthy soil, healthy food, and a healthy Illinois.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, CATHERINE ADDUCI, President of the Village of River Forest, do hereby proclaim, in recognition of the efforts of the Compost Research & Education Foundation and Illinois Food Scrap & Composting Coalition, as well as extension agents, soil conservation stewards, householders, landscapers, farmers, recyclers, public workers, composters, gardeners, and plant growers everywhere, does hereby proclaim the first full week of May as "Compost Awareness Week" in the Village of River Forest.

Subj: Adoption of Fiscal Year 2026-2027 Compensation Plan

Issue:

The Village of River Forest's compensation plan is intended to provide an attractive flexible, and market-based compensation plan tied to performance and aligned with the village's goals and interests. The goal is for the Village of River Forest to be competitive in recruiting and retaining employees through its high-quality compensation practices. Equally important, compensation practices are a means for communicating the Village's performance standards and motivating and rewarding employees relative to their achievements.

In 2012 the Village adopted a compensation plan with structured pay grades and a mechanism for moving employees through pay ranges. The staff reviews this plan annually. Recommended revisions are presented to the Village Board for annual adoption in advance of the new Fiscal Year.

Analysis:

Staff examined both internal and external comparable data and the hiring climate to determine appropriate adjustments to salary ranges. To continue to be competitive in recruiting and retaining top talent based on market conditions, staff recommends a 3% market adjustment to salary ranges for non-union personnel for Fiscal Year 2026-2027.

Due to an unexpected retirement, staff recommend the Building Department be reorganized. The recommendation is to not replace the Building Official position at this time; however, staff recommend upgrading the Building and Zoning Inspector position to the Building Department Manager. This new position will supervise the Administrative Clerk – Permit Technician position as well as conduct and oversee plan reviews, field inspections, enforcement activities, and coordination with third-party consultants. The position also facilitates the Zoning Board of Appeals and Development Review Board processes, supporting hearings, applications, and communications with stakeholders.

A motion to approve an Ordinance adopting the amended Fiscal Year 2026-2027 compensation Plan.

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE FISCAL YEAR 2026-2027 COMPENSATION PLAN

WHEREAS, in Fiscal Year 2013 the Board of Trustees considered the salary structure of the municipal employees and determined that a comprehensive analysis and revision of the compensation system was required;

WHEREAS, upon completion of a Compensation Study conducted by Voorhees Associates, the Board of Trustees implemented a compensation system with established pay grades and pay ranges and salary adjustments based on merit and performance;

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year of the Village of River Forest begins on May 1, 2026, and the Budget Ordinance for the Village has been adopted.

NOW, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of River Forest, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: The President and Board of Trustees find that all of the recitals set forth above are true and correct, and there are hereby incorporated by reference as if set forth fully.

Section 2: The Fiscal Year 2026-2027 Compensation Plan is hereby approved, as shown as attached Exhibit A and applies to all non-union employees.

Section 3: The Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to take all necessary steps to carry out this Ordinance, as shown in the Fiscal Year 2026-2027 Compensation Plan for all non-union employees, attached as Exhibit A and accordingly, is authorized to adjust the compensation of non-union employees in accordance with the established pay ranges as set forth in Exhibit A.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall take effect on May 1, 2026.

SUBJECT: Approval of Purchase – Public Works Pickup Truck

Issue: Staff is seeking approval to purchase a 2026 Ford F-350 with a plow.

Analysis: Included in the draft FY 2027 Budget (Capital Equipment Replacement Fund) is an allocation of \$65,000 for the replacement of the 2015 Ford F-350 pickup truck (Unit #49). Staff recommends replacement of this vehicle due to its age (11 years). Although the truck was originally scheduled for replacement in FY 2024, the purchase has been deferred based on the vehicle's condition.

Sutton Ford of Matteson, Illinois, procured through the Sourcewell cooperative purchasing program, provides the lowest available pricing outside of paying full retail cost. Sourcewell is a self-funded government agency that facilitates cooperative procurement by offering competitively solicited contracts to governmental and nonprofit entities. The program serves as an intermediary between purchasers and vendors, streamlining the procurement process and reducing administrative burden, vetting vendors and offering pre-negotiated, national-volume pricing, saving members time and money.

Recommendation: Concur with staff's recommendation to purchase a 2026 Ford F-350 Super Duty from Sutton Ford of Matteson, Illinois, through the Sourcewell cooperative purchasing program in the amount of \$49,963.00; to purchase the plow assembly and have it installed from Regional Truck Equipment for \$8,764.00; and to authorize lighting, bed liner, headache rack, and decal upgrades. The total project cost is \$63,000.00.

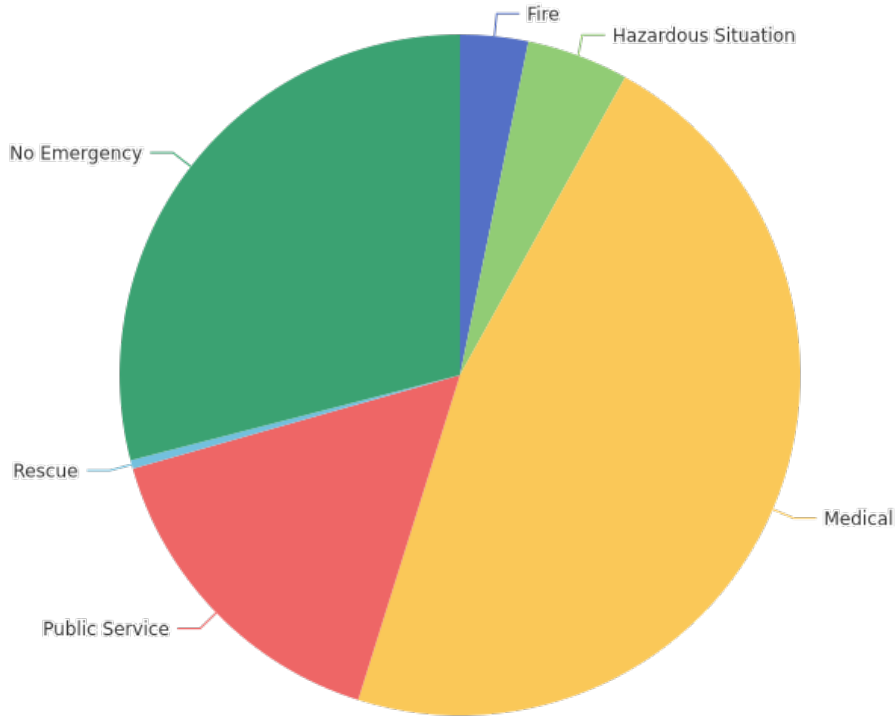

April Fire Prevention Focus

April public messaging this month emphasized:

Keep Your Home Safe

- Install a smoke alarm inside each sleeping area and on each level of your home.
- Sleep with doors closed.
- Vacuum and dust smoke alarms weekly.
- Test each smoke alarm once a month. Replace bad batteries immediately.
- Replace all smoke alarm batteries at least twice a year.
- Replace smoke alarms every 10 years.
- Keep one or more working fire extinguishers in your home and know how to use them.
- Keep matches and lighters safely out of reach of children.
- Never leave something cooking on the stove unattended and keep the cooking area clutter free.

Make a Plan

- Determine at least two escape routes from every room of your home.
- Select a location outside your home where everyone will meet after escaping.
- Practice your escape plan at least once a month.
- Consider escape ladders for sleeping areas on the second or third floor. Learn how to use them and store them near the window.
- Consider installing an automatic fire sprinkler system in your home.

A regular meeting of the Village of River Forest Board of Trustees was held on April 13th, 2026, at 7:00 p.m. in the Community Room of Village Hall, 400 Park Avenue – River Forest, IL.

1. CALL TO ORDER/ROLL CALL

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. Upon roll call, the following persons were:

Present: President Adduci, Brennan, Gillis, O’Connell(Virtual), Keskitalo, Vazquez, and Village Clerk Castellano

Absent: Trustee Bachner

Also Present: Village Attorney Lance Malina, Village Administrator Matt Walsh, Assistant Village Administrator Jessica Spencer, Fire Chief Tom Gaertner, Director of Public Works and Engineering Jack Bielak, Police Chief James Greenwood, Deputy Police Chief Michael Swierczynski, Police Commander Martin Grill, Finance Director Rosemary McAdams, HR Manager Trish Ivansek, and Assistant to the Director of Public Works Seth Jansen.

MOTION by Trustee Vazquez to allow Trustee O’Connell to participate in the meeting virtually due to employment reasons. Seconded by Trustee Gillis.

2. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

President Adduci led the Pledge of Allegiance.

3.CITIZEN COMMENTS

Homer Bizzle highlighted several upcoming events for the charity America Cares Too, which he represents. He also provided updates on additional programs and other activities related to the organization.

4. PUBLIC HEARING – FISCAL YEAR 2027 OPERATING BUDGET

a. Presentation of FY 2027 Operating Budget

Village Administrator Matt Walsh and Finance Director Rosemary McAdams presented the Fiscal Year 2027 operating budget and fielded questions from members of the Board.

Trustee Brennan noted a possible scrivener’s error in the budget regarding the use of “personal services” versus “personnel services.”

President Adduci requested clarification on the fees and costs related to the Village’s waste contract, and Administrator Walsh provided an explanation.

Trustee Vazquez requested clarification regarding the three-year projection of the General Fund. Director McAdams stated that the 2027 projection is balanced, while the subsequent two years reflect projected deficits.

Trustee Keskitalo asked how inflation is accounted for in the projections, and Director McAdams provided an explanation of the assumptions used.

Trustee O’Connell asked whether the Village is considering installing EV charging stations in the Town Center shopping area. Administrator Walsh stated that there are no plans to do so at this time.

Trustee Vazquez asked how long the three-month delay has occurred for a particular revenue source. Director McAdams noted that the delay has existed for at least 20 years and provided an explanation of its cause.

Trustee Gillis asked whether the Village has an estimate of the average annual revenue received from grants. Director McAdams noted that the amount is variable due to the impact of larger projects.

President Adduci thanked staff for their work on the budget, noted the limited actions available to the Village regarding its finances, and encouraged staff to continue pursuing outside funding sources, such as grants, to help increase revenues. She added that whenever the Village is able to realize savings and return those benefits to residents, such as through the 50/50 lead replacement program, it should do so. She also stated that the number one concern raised by residents is traffic and safety and encouraged staff to continue advancing projects and initiatives aimed at mitigating these concerns.

b. Public Hearing – FY 2027 Village Operating Budget

Administrator Walsh opened the Public Hearing and there were no public comments regarding the budget.

Trustee Gillis noted that April 18 is the Earth Day Thatcher Woods cleanup hosted by the Park District and encouraged residents to sign up. She also recognized a resident for their volunteer work with the River Forest Bike Exchange and thanked the various groups and organizations that make the event possible. She further encouraged the Village to consider establishing a yearly award to recognize residents who make a positive impact on the community.

Trustee Vazquez thanked staff for their work on the budget and acknowledged the awards the Village has received related to its budgeting efforts. He also congratulated the Village on being named a finalist for the All-American City Award.

Administrator Walsh noted that the winner of the All-America City Award will be announced at the June event.

Trustee Vazquez reminded residents of the dangers of scams and highlighted a recent text message scam he received impersonating the court system.

Village Clerk Castellano congratulated and thanked staff for their work on the budget.

Trustee Brennan began her comments with a land acknowledgment and highlighted a Village partnership with Ecoship that helps recycle packaging materials and tennis shoes.

Trustee Vazquez asked how long the collection box will be available, and Trustee Brennan stated it will be available for one month.

a. Right-of-Way Encroachment Agreement Process Update

Village Administrator Matt Walsh provided background information on the agenda item.

Trustee O’Connell expressed support for potential changes and inquired how landscaping and fences located within the right of way would be addressed.

Director Bielak explained the current right of way encroachment process.

Trustee Vazquez asked whether the proposed code would include a mechanism allowing residents or neighboring property owners to appeal decisions to the Village Board.

Director Bielak stated that an appeals process could be incorporated and noted that similar processes exist in other sections of the Village Code.

Village Administrator Walsh confirmed that an appeals process could be implemented.

Trustee Gillis asked for confirmation that no items may be placed in the right of way without Village approval.

Director Bielak stated that items should not be placed in the parkway without approval.

Trustee Brennan noted that plants are commonly placed in the parkway.

Director Bielak acknowledged this and stated that the Village retains the right to remove such plantings as necessary to perform work within the right of way.
