STATE OF ILLINOIS MANDATES

- WITH CHANGES IN THE STATUTORY REQUIREMENTS, THERE ARE NOW A TOTAL OF 17 MANDATED TRAINING
 CATEGORIES
- Frequency of trainings range from yearly to every five years
- ALL TRAININGS HAVE TO BE APPROVED BY ILETSB
- Mandates continue to be unfunded by the state and costs are passed on to the local municipality

- THE DEPARTMENT HAS BEEN IN CONTACT WITH THE STATE TO ADDRESS THIS ISSUE.
- WE ARE CURRENTLY DEVELOPING IN SERVICE TRAININGS AT RFPD REFERENCE THE NEW MANDATES
- THESE COURSES WILL BE SUBMITTED TO THE STATE FOR CERTIFICATION
- THE DEPARTMENT WILL CONDUCT YEARLY IN HOUSE TRAININGS, THAT WILL COVER THE MANDATES
- GIVES US THE ABILITY TO TAILOR THE TRAININGS TO OUR DEPARTMENT AND COMMUNITY

<u>A</u>CTIVE

BYSTANDERSHIP FOR

LAW

ENFORCEMENT

GOAL: TO PREPARE OFFICERS TO SUCCESSFULLY INTERVENE TO PREVENT HARM AND TO CREATE A LAW ENFORCEMENT CULTURE THAT SUPPORTS PEER INTERVENTION.

WHY SHOULD WE GET INVOLVED?

- ACTIVE BYSTANDERSHIP IS A PROVEN MODEL IN REDUCING HARM IN HIGH-STRESS, HIGH-STAKES DECISION MAKING (E.G. MEDICAL PROFESSIONALS, COLLEGE CAMPUSES, AIRLINE INDUSTRY).
- THESE TOOLS CAN HELP PREVENT UNNECESSARY HARM IN LAW ENFORCEMENT. PREVENTING MISTAKES AND MISCONDUCT WHILE PROMOTING OFFICERS' HEALTH AND WELLBEING.

HOW IS THIS DIFFERENT FROM "DUTY TO INTERVENE" TRAINING?

- DUTY TO INTERVENE IS TYPICALLY TAUGHT WITH EMPHASIS ON THE LEGAL DUTY ITSELF. ABLE FOCUSES ON HOW TO INTERVENE SUCCESSFULLY, OFFERING SKILLS BASED TRAINING IN THE SCIENCE OF ACTIVE BYSTANDERSHIP.
- OFFICERS ARE TRAINED IN HOW TO GIVE AND RECEIVE INTERVENTION.
- IN ADDITION TO THE INITIAL TRAINING, ABLE HELPS AGENCIES CREATE A CLIMATE IN WHICH ACTIVE BYSTANDERSHIP IS WELCOME AND EFFECTIVE.

STEPS IN BECOMING AN "ABLE" AGENCY

EACH AGENCY ACCEPTED INTO THE PROGRAM MUST ABIDE BY THE "10
 ABLE STANDARDS" AND SUBMIT LETTERS FROM COMMUNITY GROUPS
 VOUCHING FOR THE AGENCY'S SINCERE COMMITMENT TO ABLE.

• THE STANDARDS AND COMMUNITY LETTERS ALONE MAKE ABLE FAR DIFFERENT FROM TRADITIONAL DUTY-TO-INTERVENE TRAININGS.

- Free Train-the-Trainer program for agencies.
- CERTIFICATION AND TRAINING PORTALS FOR INSTRUCTORS TO TEACH THEIR AGENCIES.
- FREE ONGOING IMPLEMENTATION AND TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE.
- ABLE WILL ALSO PROVIDE "A WIDE ARRAY OF RESOURCES TO COMMUNITIES AND LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES" FOR DEVELOPING PEER INTERVENTION PROGRAMS OF THEIR OWN.
- ADDS ADDITIONAL TRANSPARENCY AND ACCOUNTABILITY FOR ALL STAKEHOLDERS.

WHERE IS RIVER FOREST IN THE "ABLE" PROCESS?

- AD HOC COMMITTEE OF COMMAND, SUPERVISORS, AND FRONT-LINE PERSONNEL EVALUATED THE VALUE AND BENEFITS OF THE PROGRAM.
- Letters of support have been received from Dominican university and river forest public school district 90, and the community center as part of the APPLICATION PROCESS.
- THE CHIEF OF POLICE HAS PREPARED A LETTER OF SUPPORT AND INTENT TO ADOPT THE GEORGETOWN UNIVERSITY "ABLE" PROGRAM.
- The final step prior to final submission is a letter of support from the Village President; which is being drafted at this time.
- THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES WILL BE PROVIDED WITH STATUS UPDATES ON THIS IMPORTANT INITIATIVE.
