- A scaled floor plan, diagram, or drawing in detail satisfactory to the local liquor commissioner illustrating the premises where alcoholic liquor is to be sold or served.

- A copy of a certificate of liquor liability insurance naming the Village of River Forest, 400 Park Avenue, River Forest IL 60305 as the certificate holder for the period during which liquor will be used and naming the Village of River Forest, its officials, employees, agents and volunteers as additional insured. The coverage shall be in an amount sufficient to cover the maximum amount of liability under the Illinois Liquor Control Act. (8-5-8.B.24)
- Such additional information or identification as the local liquor commissioner determines desirable in order to establish the character and business plans of the applicant. (8-5-8.B.25)

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## By attachment of his/her signature,

- the applicant, or the person signing on behalf of the applicant, and all individuals required to be identified in this application affirm that they have never been convicted of a felony or a Class A misdemeanor and are not disqualified to receive a liquor license by reason of any matter or thing contained in the laws of the State of Illinois or the provisions of this chapter.
- the applicant affirms that he/she and all individuals required to be identified in this application have not in the past, and will not in the future, violate any of the laws of the State of Illinois, or of the United States, or any ordinance of the Village, controlling the retail sale of alcoholic liquor and the conduct of his place of business. - the applicant affirms that he/she, and all individuals required to be identified in this application, have never sold, delivered, or given away alcoholic liquor in violation of any state law, or Village ordinance, to a person under the minimum age required to purchase or possess liquor.
