- Billions of birds migrate yearly in the spring and fall, flying at night.

## HOW TO HELP

- Turn off unnecessary exterior decorative lighting from 11pm to 6am
- Avoid over-lighting with brighter technology
- Use motion sensors and down-shielded light fixtures
- Close blinds
- Choose warmer colors, which attract birds less
