MINOR CONSENT ASSUMPTION OF RISK, WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND RELEASE JUNIOR CITIZENS POLICE ACADEMY

I understand that my minor child or ward ("Child") is voluntarily participating in the Village of River Forest's and the Village of Oak Park's ("Villages") Junior Citizens Police Academy ("JCPA" or "Academy") operated by the respective Villages' Police Departments. I attest that my Child is between ten (10) and fifteen (15) years of age and that I have the legal authority to execute this Consent on his or her behalf.

By signing below, I agree on behalf of myself and my Child, and our heirs, assigns, executors and administrators, to release and hold harmless the Villages and their officers, employees, volunteers, agents, and assigns, from any and all personal injuries, including death, property damages, losses, suits, costs (including reasonable attorneys' fees), claims, damages, expenses, judgments, liabilities, or liens, arising directly or indirectly from my Child's participation in the JCPA during any applicable period that my Child participates in the Academy, unless the above mentioned injuries, damages or losses are the result of a willful or wanton act or conduct by the Villages.

I recognize that the JCPA will include physical activity and that my Child may encounter natural and manmade hazards, environmental conditions, and other similar conditions. I affirmatively state that my Child is free from any known heart or other health problems that might prevent him or her from participating in any of the activities associated with the Academy and that my Child is sufficiently physically fit to participate in JCPA activities.

I understand that health insurance coverage is not provided to my Child as part of his or her participation in the JCPA. I certify that I have medical insurance in amounts sufficient to cover the cost of any emergency or other medical care for my Child as a result of my Child's participation in the Academy. I affirmatively state that if I do not have medical insurance, I shall be personally responsible for the cost of any emergency or other medical care provided to my Child as a result of his or her participation in the Academy.

My Child shall comply with the Villages' guidelines, rules, orders, directions, instructions and regulations regarding his or her participation in the Academy and I waive any and all claims and causes of action resulting from his or her failure to follow said rules, orders, directions, instructions, and regulations. I attest that my Child's participation in the JCPA is strictly voluntary and that I am allowing my Child to participate at his or her own risk.
